**Ssk** - slip, slip, knit these 2 stitches together—a decrease

**Sssk** - slip, slip, slip, knit 3 stitches together

St(s) - stitch(es)

St st - stockinette stitch

Tbl - through back loop

Tog - together

WS - wrong side

Wyib - with yarn in back

Wyif - with yarn in front

Yfwd - yarn forward

Yo - yarn over

Yrn - varn around needle

Yon - yarn over needle

[] or () - work instructions within brackets as many times as directed

\* - repeat the instructions following the single asterisk as directed

\*\* - repeat instructions between asterisks as many times as directed or repeat from a given set of instructions
